

# ESCC Tornado Drill Information

## March 16, 2010 - 9:45 AM

1. At 8:00 a.m. an ESCC Alert message will be sent as a reminder and to help prepare for the drill. The alert will announce that this is a drill only and that classes are in session all day.
2. At 9:45 a.m. air horns will sound as the indication that the drill has begun.
3. The safest places during a tornado are windowless interior rooms or interior halls. For this drill all of the safe areas will be marked with a tornado symbol and wording indicating this is a safe location.
4. If not already positioned in a safe area, then move to the closest safe area.
5. People should crouch as low as possible to the floor, face down, and cover their heads with their hands.
6. Volunteers will be assisting throughout the buildings to ensure that everyone is in a safe area.
7. The air horns will sound again to indicate that the drill is over and normal operations will resume.
